

#### 1st Wednesday: Yetter Park 📵

198-184 Wilson Ave. (end of Roosevelt Avenue), East Stroudsburg, Pa.
All first Wednesdays of the month will meet at Yetter Park and loop north around Brodhead Creek Park for a total walking distance of 2.2 miles. Points of interest: manmade waterfall, forest This is a flat, gravel trail.

## 2nd Wednesday: ForEvergreen Nature Preserve 20

1539 Cherry Lane Road, East
Stroudsburg, Pa.
All second Wednesdays of the month
will meet at ForEvergreen Nature
Preserve and walk an outer and inner
loop for a total walking distance of 1.5
miles. Points of interest: forest, meadow.
This is a mostly flat trail with some hills.
The trail is part gravel, part grass. In wet
conditions, there may be mud.

#### 3rd Wednesday: Yetter Park 📵

198-184 Wilson Ave. (end of Roosevelt Avenue), East Stroudsburg, Pa.
All third Wednesdays of the month will meet at Yetter Park and loop 1.5 miles south around East Stroudsburg High School athletic fields. Points of interest: creekside, forest This is a mostly flat, gravel trail.

#### 4th Wednesday: Pinebrook Park 116

4070 N. Fifth St., East Stroudsburg, Pa. On fourth Wednesdays of the month, we will meet at Pinebrook Park's North Parking Lot (across from Hallet Road) and walk south along the creek, over a hill, and through Brodhead Creek Park before circling back around (2 miles). Points of interest: Creekside, bridges, pond, open views. Flat, wide, gravel walk with some bridges. One large, cardio-demanding hill.

## 5th Wednesday (if applicable): Grab bag!

#### April 19, 2025: Fieldstone Farm Preserve; Pocono Heritage Land Trust

A rushing creek descending quickly down the hillside past a historic farmhouse makes this a charming I-mile loop something to see. Some hills. Wooded trail with rocks, roots, mud and creek crossings. This trail requires dexterity. Estimated time I hour. Meets at Tank Creek Nature Preserve: 512 Devils Hole Road, Cresco.

## May 17, 2025: Brodhead Creek Park STRUCTURED DOG PACK WALK; Stroud Township

Walk your dog along this wooded creekside trail with a pack of pups. About 1.8 miles. Trail is gravel with one moderately taxing hill and a short roadside section. Estimated time: I hour. Meets at 4002 N. Fifth St, East Stroudsburg, Pa.

Please note: A dog pack walk is a structured, leashed walk. Dogs are NOT permitted to physically greet each other at any time. On pack walks, dogs are encouraged to walk alongside one another at a healthy distance. This builds trust and provides enrichment without creating defensive or insecure behaviors. This pack walk is a great opportunity to meet other pet owners and help your dog learn good manners.

Please bring a 6-foot or shorter leash and poop bags to clean up after your dog. Plan to walk far apart at the start of the walk, and possibly maintain that distance depending on behavioral cues from your pet and those around you. Disrespectful or aggressively behaved dogs will not be permitted on the walk and must leave when asked. Dogs must be licensed and properly vaccinated to attend.

After the walk at 11 a.m., you are welcome to stay to attend a free Dog Training Q&A Session with University of Pets trainer David Henon. More information on page xxx.

#### June 21, 2025: Kurmes Preserve; Pocono Heritage Land Trust

A refreshing, slightly challenging hike loop of 2 miles. Rhododendrons and mountain laurels hug the trail, and some will likely be blooming. A creek meets the trail at certain points. Rocks, roots, mud and dips and rises in trail all require balance. Estimated time: I hour. Meets at 335 Devils Hole Road, Cresco, Pa.

#### July 19, 2025: Rail Gap Preserve; Pocono Heritage Land Trust

Rushing water and hemlock forest – a short but remarkable creekside hike of about 0.5 miles. Rocks and roots sporadically in path. Some slight hills. Estimated time: 30 minutes. Rail Gap Preserve is at 3555 Schafer Schoolhouse Road, Stroudsburg.

#### August 16, 2025: Columcille Megalith Park; Columcille Inc.

A contemplative and relaxed walk through mesmerizing rock structures and forest Lots of points of interest along this short hike! About 0.5 miles. A few cardio-demanding hills, and some rocks and roots in some trails, but otherwise a fairly flat walk.

Estimated time 45 minutes. This private land is open to the public on a donation basis. Please consider donating to the park if you attend. Parking for the area is along Quaker Plain Road, right after it turns off Fox Gap Road.

## September 20, 2025: Cherry Valley National Wildlife Refuge; U. S. Fish & Wildlife Service

An invigorating stroll over the creek and rolling meadowed hills of the sunny Cherry Valley. About 2 miles. Paved trail; several cardio-heavy hills. Estimated time: I hour. Dogs are not allowed at this location. There are two Cherry Valley National Wildlife Refuges in the area. We will meet at the one that was once a golf course: 2138 Crossdale Road, Stroudsburg. Please make sure that you are heading to the right address before you start your drive.

#### October 18, 2025: Indian Loop; Big Pocono State Park

Scenic views during foliage season! Drive to the top of Camelback Mountain and take a hike out through scrub oak habitat to a scenic vista and back. A bit over a 1 mile loop. This is one of our more difficult Saturday Strolls. Some slight rock scrambles, regular rocks and roots on trail. No major elevation changes, but some climbs and descending slopes. Dexterity required. Meets at Big Pocono State Park Parking Lot #4 on Rim Road, Tannersville.

#### November 15, 2025: Lower Hornbeck Trail; Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area

Walk to a waterfall! Join us on a pristine journey over idyllic footbridges to the waterfall and then back again. About 2 miles. Path is mostly flat gravel with some rocky sections, bridges have steps up and require a bit of dexterity. Estimated time: 1.5 hours. Meets at Lower Hornbeck's Creek Trailhead. If lot is full, there is overflow parking across 209. Give yourself plenty of time to arrive, as this is our farthest destination from town this year, and overflow parking is a short but noticeable walk to the trailhead. Go to our website for a link to the trailhead location, or call us for directions.

#### December 20, 2025: Cherry Creek Crossing Loop; Smithfield Township

A fun-loving waterside loop to and from Minisink Park. About 2.5 miles of mostly flat, gravel trail except slight hill to and from the creek. Stone creek crossing is delightful, though it does require some dexterity. Estimated time: 1.5 hours. Meet off Oak Street, Delaware Water Gap (NOT at Minisink Park). Go to our website for a link to the trailhead location, or call us for directions.




